Securely Contacting LISTen.

To securely contact the production team behind *LISTen: The LISNews.org Podcast*, there are some steps that need to be taken. On the production team's end, the encryption tool used is GnuPG. To securely encrypt communications to the production team, messages must be sent in a manner related to the OpenPGP standard.

GnuPG can be downloaded from <http://gnupg.org>. Installing this is not a simple, turn-key matter. Potential correspondents should exercise the utmost caution in attempting to use this particular software package as Erie Looking Productions offers absolutely no warranty, whether implied or otherwise, relative to this third-party package.

To securely contact *LISTen* for the first time, a specific set of steps must be carried out:

1. If not already installed, GnuPG or a compatible package must be installed.
2. If not already generated, a key pair must be generated in the package installed.
3. If not already submitted to a public key server, the public key must be submitted to a public key server for dissemination.
4. After such is in place, the public key for the production team should be downloaded. At the present time, the KeyID for that public key is **899C131F**.
5. After such is in place, a message may then be encrypted with the production team as the recipient and then sent.

Although files can be submitted securely using an encryption package, it is requested that correspondents first contact the production team before sending.
